Elgin Golf Club was formed in 1906, it is a testing heathland course measuring 6449 yards, with a par of 69, and a standard scratch of 71, fully justifying its claim to be one of the finest inland courses in the northern part of Scotland.

## Competitive Golf

Members can play in a range of competitions in varying formats including Stablefords, Medals, Greensomes, and Texas scrambles to name but a few. Competitions are played both during the week and at weekends. Seniors competitions are primarily played on Thursday. Ladies competitions are played on Tuesdays and Gents & mixed competitions are played primarily on a Wednesday & Saturday. There will also be various Opens throughout the year including our Gents & Ladies 5 day open in July.

## Practice Facilities

We are pleased to offer a variety of practice facilities free of charge to members, their guests, and playing visitors. These facilities are normally available for use throughout the year, and are strategically located within the course grounds. The different practice facilities include:

### **Practice Area & Putting Green**

We maintain the practice area and putting green to the same standard as the greens on the course, accurately reflecting the surfaces you will find when playing including many contours for realistic practice. The Practice Area is located behind the locker rooms and the putting green is located beside the patio area.

### **Driving Range**

The driving range is an outdoor facility which is for members only at the moment. It is ideal for practicing all shots.
